

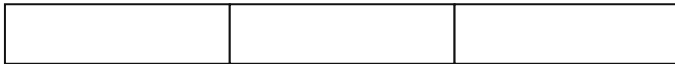

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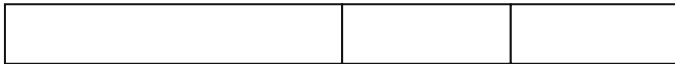

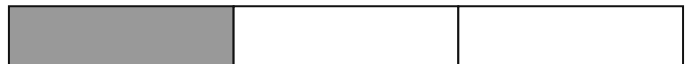


2. This bar is split into halves. How many equal shares make one whole?

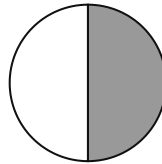

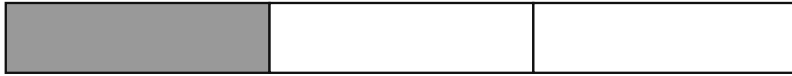
