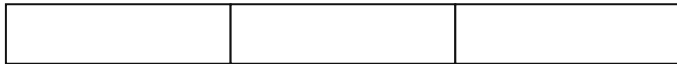


Read and build fraction models

1. Shade 0 of the 3 equal parts to make $\frac{0}{3}$.



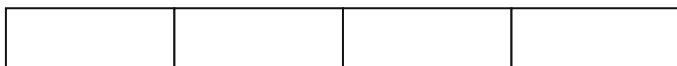
Shade the parts in the model above.

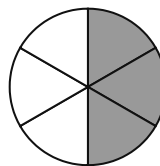

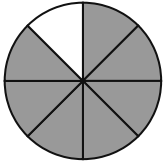

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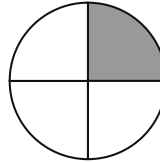

7. A paper design uses the shaded parts of one whole strip. What fraction is used?

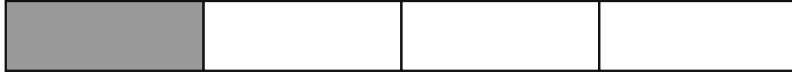
