5. A paper design uses the shaded parts of one whole disc. What fraction is used?



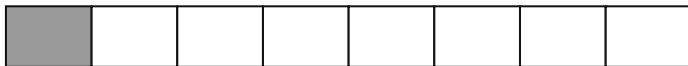

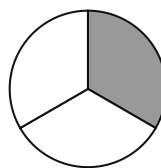
