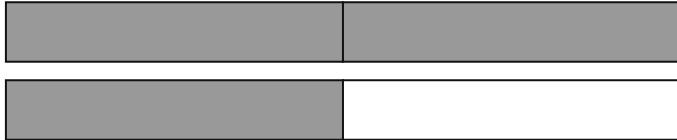

1. Fill in the missing numerator: $\frac{3}{2} = \frac{?}{4}$.



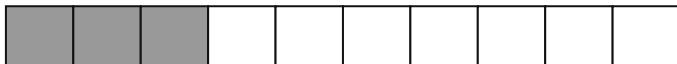

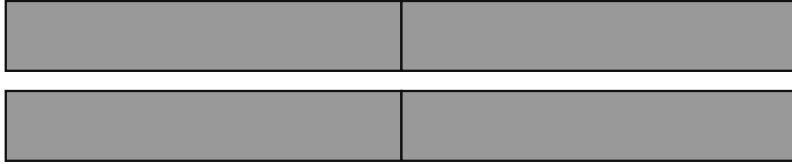

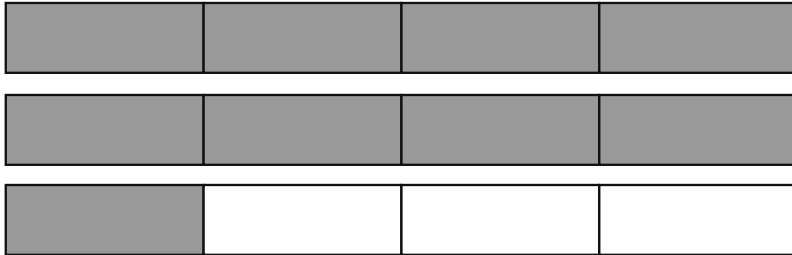


- A. Each old part becomes 2 smaller equal parts. Change both numerator and denominator by the same factor.
