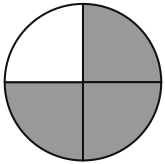

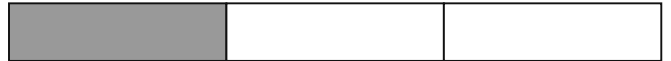

1. This circle is split into fourths. How many equal shares make one whole?



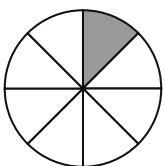
